

Ministry Job Description

Position: Vacation Bible School teacher

Goal of Position: to joyfully share the Word of God with the children at VBS, so that children in our community can be drawn to Jesus in a fun and exciting event.

Responsible to: VBS Program Director

Job Description:

- study the daily lesson and prepare the stories, songs, and activities you want to do with the children;
- teach the lesson and lead the activities
- interact personally with the children, demonstrating the love of Jesus
- guide the children in your class to the various departments for the other activities (worship, crafts, music, puppets, and recreation)

Time Required: one 2-hour training meeting; 4 to 5 hours personal preparation time; the 5 mornings of VBS (third week in July).

Length of commitment: one VBS session, with renewals as desired

Training Provided: The training session and the teacher's book provide all the information needed for teaching the lessons, plus information on schedules, procedures, etc. New teachers are paired with an experienced teacher for the first year.

Qualifications or special skills:

- love for the children
- desire to share Jesus with them
- ability to talk with them in a way they will understand
- ability to interact with them and keep their attention in a positive manner

Benefits to the volunteer: You will have fun with the children as you get to know them personally, and you will have the blessing of knowing that you are enhancing each child's knowledge of Jesus as their Savior. Many children remember VBS experiences all their lives. Plus you'll get a great seat at the puppet show!
